



STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR

Outdoor Properties Owned by the City of Longmont

Purpose Statement: The City of Longmont provides facilities and services to customers and community members in a variety of settings and facilities. An atmosphere of respect, courtesy, welcome, and business has been established and will be maintained on City property.

These Standards of Behavior are intended to protect the rights and safety of citizens and visitors while prohibiting persons from unreasonably interfering with other persons' use of City facilities and protect City facilities, equipment and grounds. These Standards of Behavior shall apply to all outdoor property owned by the City of Longmont with the exception of sidewalks, right of ways, parks, trails, and other land regulated in chapter 13.20 ("Public Lands") of the Longmont Municipal Code, and unless otherwise noted below.


TIER 1

Behaviors, language, and items not tolerated under any circumstance include:	Tier 1 Response to infractions:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Illegal drugs possession and associated paraphernalia. ○ Marijuana use. ○ Unlawfully carrying a concealed or unconcealed firearm. ○ Promotion of obscenity, wholesale promotion of obscenity, public indecency, indecent exposure. ○ Assault, harassment. ○ Smoking cigarettes and e-cigarettes where prohibited by law. ○ Vandalism, theft, abuse, or damage of the facility or its contents, or another person's belongings. ○ Consumption of alcohol/liquor except where allowed by license. ○ Littering. ○ Any obstruction of a sidewalk that actually prevents a person from passing, or makes such passage unreasonably inconvenient or hazardous. ○ Any criminal conduct not otherwise listed above. 	<p>You may be asked to discontinue the behavior by staff; and/or law enforcement may be called and a ticket may be issued for violations of the law.</p>

TIER 2

Other related behavior issues which may be deemed inappropriate and not allowed:	Tier 2 Response to infractions:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Leaving personal property unattended, including but not limited to bags and backpacks.○ Possession of weapons other than firearms, except as permitted by law.○ Pornography viewing.○ Sexual activity or simulated sexual acts.○ Fighting.○ Profane, threatening, abusive, or racially disparaging language, gestures, and behaviors.○ Intimidation of others.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. You will be asked to discontinue the behavior and given a verbal warning, which staff shall document in writing.2. Staff may call law enforcement for additional reinforcement regarding this behavior.3. If behavior escalates, law enforcement may ask you to leave and give a trespass warning.4. If person violates the trespass warning, you may be issued a trespass ticket.
