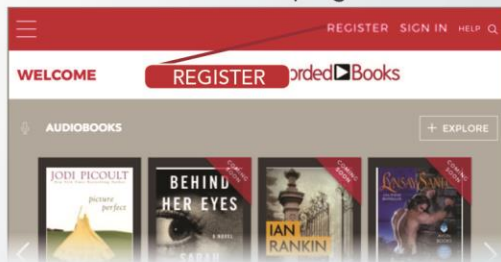


WELCOME!

RBdigital offers an easy way to access audiobooks and eBooks from your library. Follow these instructions to use the service with your mobile devices.

Getting Started

- 1 First-time users need to set up an RBdigital account. From your library's RBdigital site, select **REGISTER** at the top right.



- 2 Search in your device's app store and download the free RBdigital app.



*Depending on when you are accessing RBdigital, you may see one of these two logos.

- 3 After installing the app, select **OPEN** from the app store or select the app icon from your device screen.

- 4 Log in to your app with the username/email and password used to create your RBdigital account. Select your country, state/province, and library name.

Checking Out Titles

- 1 If you currently have audiobook or eBook titles checked out, they will appear on the dashboard.
- 2 To check out a title, click the **EXPLORE** icon. You can search by title, author, keyword, genre, and narrator (for audiobooks).



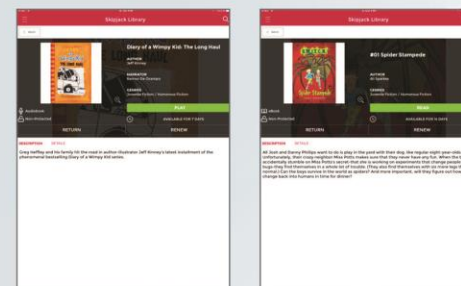

- 3 Once you've made your selection, click **CHECKOUT**. This title will now show up on your dashboard page.

Listening to Audiobooks and Reading eBooks

- 1 On your dashboard screen, click the tab for audiobooks and eBooks.
- 2 Select the **INFORMATION** icon to get information on your checked-out book and to **RENEW/RETURN** and update **SETTINGS**.
- 3 Select the **DOWNLOAD** icon and then select the **PLAY** icon for audiobooks or **READ** icon for eBooks.
- 4 In Read or Play mode, select the **SETTINGS** icon to update your reading/listening preferences.
