What I Will Keep Working For:

- **HOUSING: HOUSING IS HUGE.** Protecting what we have from being scraped or turned into tourist housing; increasing variety of housing stock and homes for purchase. Restoring the 10% affordable housing requirement that was terminated by the a previous Council. **When we do not have living wage jobs, we cannot buy a home and we rent. When we cannot afford to rent, we become homeless.**
- **CIVIL RIGHTS:** Many of Longmont's residents have been under increased attack nationally and locally. America must not go backward. Increased collaboration with the various organizations supporting our fellow residents would move Longmont forward so that everyone has the opportunity to flourish.
- **DEFENSE OF FRACKING BAN:** The Colorado Supreme Court ruled **our home-rule ban fracking within the city limits** was illegal. I will continue to stand with the majority of Longmont residents who voted for this. We have a right to protect the health and safety of ourselves and our children and to protect our property.
- **SMART DEVELOPMENT:** Development must pay its way. The developer should pay his fair share for the increase in taxpayer burdens due to his development, such as increased school, roads, police, firefighting, and utility expenses. We welcome good developers who share our community values.
- **FASTRACKS:** Longmont has been paying for fast RAIL for a long time; we deserve to get it before another decade passes. We have pushed RTD to build a larger and better station and actually **BRING** rail to Longmont. This affects our businesses, tourism, and especially our residents.
- **MEDICAL MARIJUANA:** This help to those in chronic pain should be regulated, strictly enforced for health and safety, and supported. When handled appropriately, it will bring in much needed tax revenue. Medical marijuana was banned from Longmont by previous Councils. We have been working to allow four medical/recreational marijuana shops in Longmont city limits.
- **FAIR CAMPAIGN ACT:** I support transparent political campaigns, so voters know who the real campaign donors are and how much money they are contributing. This act was essentially gutted by previous Councils by destroying the oversight committee. The committee should be restored.
