B.10	Bands - 1990 - 1991	50+	Rhythm Airs jazz band started in 1953 by Jim Harper at Longmont High School plays concerts. New versions of Rhythm Airs jazz band continue to perform. Hot Rize from Niwot quits in 1990. Concerts at Vance Brand Auditorium, Sebanton's, Footloose, and Boulder County Fair.
B.10	Bands - 1985-1989	59	Hot Rize banjo player Pete Wernick survived United plane crash. Later this year, internationally-known bluegrass band Hot Rize performed in Niwot and Erie several times. Country rock band Raz performed several times with final concert in Lyons. Rhythm Airs reunited for various benefits for Longmont High. The Coasters played at Twin Peaks Mall, Gary Lewis and the Playboys performed at Vance Brand Auditorium. Several local bands performed throughout St. Vrain Valley.
B.10	Bands - 1983-1984	50+	Hot Rize performed several concerts together. Locals Flash Cadillac and the Continental Kids performed in Longmont, as well as the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band, The New Christy Minstrels, The Grass Roots, and Rave. Various bands performed at the first Longmont Rock Festival at the Boulder County Fair Grounds including popular group Vixen. Concerts were held to raise money for Niwot High students to participate in the International Music Festival in Vienna, Austria. Several local bands performed through St. Vrain Valley.
B.10	Bands - 1971-1982	29	Longmont Jaycees' Battle of the bands winner Black Star. New Christy Minstrels performed at Vance Brand. Dillard's played at the Apple's Victorian Saloon. The Queen City Jazz Band joined the Longmont Symphony's Pops Concert at Boulder Fairgrounds and Vance Brand. Various local bands played in Longmont and Niwot, including Southern Exposure, Hot Rize, Desire, and Chicago Colony Jazz Band. Longmont's Polka Mates announce they will perform in Europe. B.10.10	Bands - The 11th Street East - 1968	0	Two band members from Longmont played for the 11th Street East band at the TAC dance.
