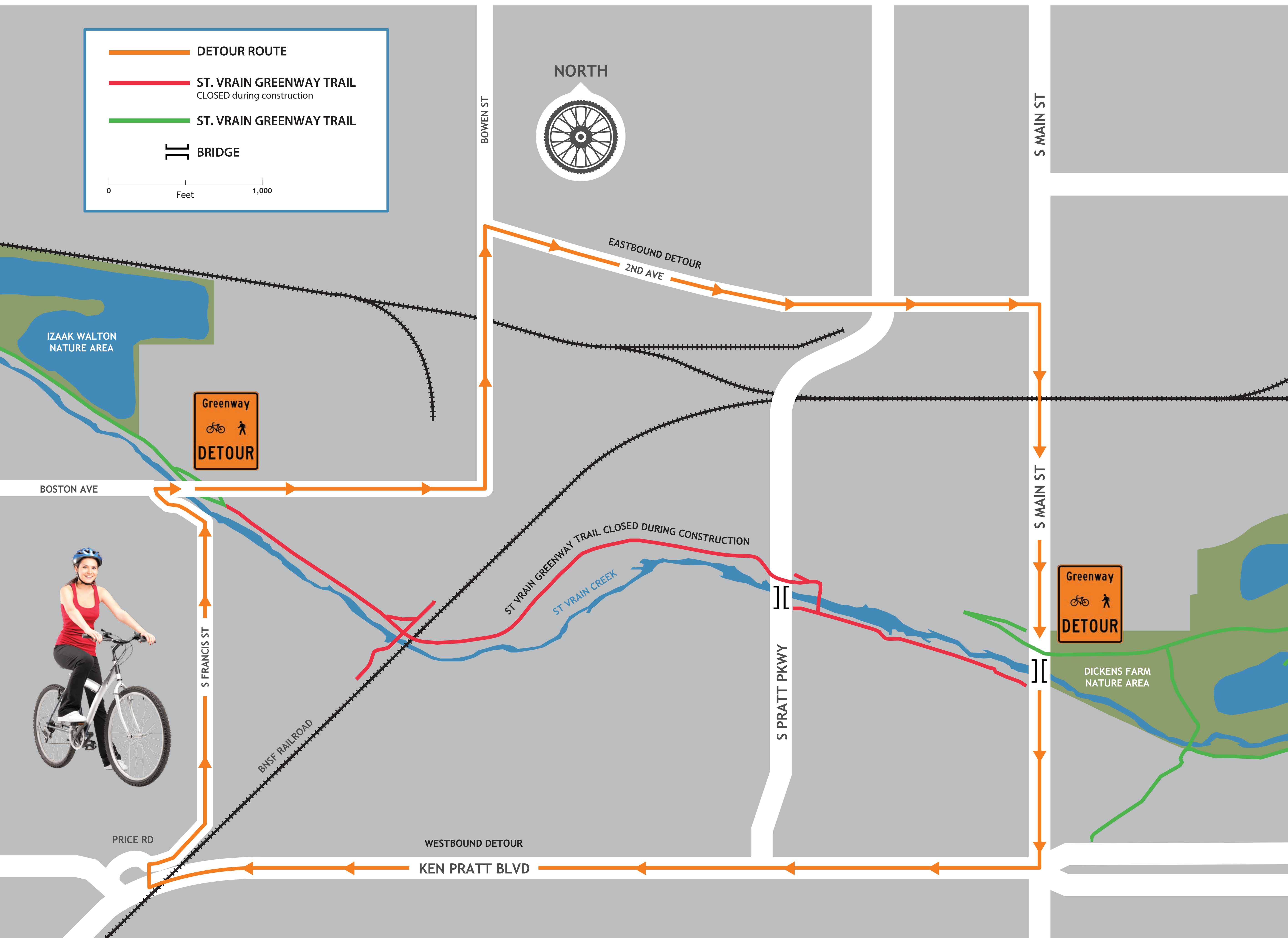


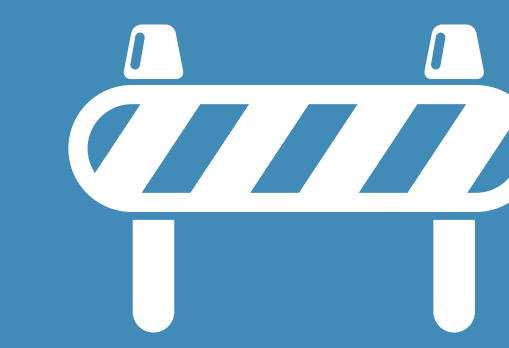
ST. VRAIN GREENWAY TRAIL DETOUR

Longmont's St. Vrain Greenway was heavily damaged by flooding in September 2013. The greenway and accompanying trail network is being repaired and restored as part of the Resilient St. Vrain Project. This work requires closing a 1-mile stretch of the trail between Main Street and Boston Avenue for improvements to the St. Vrain Creek and replacement of the BNSF Railroad Bridge.

- A **1.5-mile, on street detour** around this work area has been developed and clearly marked with signs to safely route pedestrians and people using bicycles around the work zone.
- This detour is anticipated to remain in place **through mid-2020**.
