RECENT PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

March 2020

- The Civic Center and Library were closed due to the COVID-19 crisis and recently reopened to staff and the public

April 2020

- Crews continued making structural repairs to the Civic Center Admin East Building during the closure

May 2020

- Exterior glass removal and replacements at the Civic Center
- Admin East Parking Garage repairs

June 2020

- West Library Parking Garage Stairway demolition and reconstruction
- Admin East Retaining Wall crack repairs

July 2020

- Scarification of the Plaza Area continues; dust, vibration and noise, oh my!

LIBRARY EAST ENTRANCE OPEN

We are excited the Library is open and curbside service continues. The West Library Entrance and the West stairway access from the Library Parking Garage to the Plaza Area, however, will remain closed until the needed Plaza Area repairs are complete. Just watch out for the **TEMPORARY NO PARKING** signs in the garage. These spaces are needed for work going on *above* in the Plaza Area. In addition, anticipate upcoming sidewalk/parking space closures along the east side of Kimbark Street while they finish the work.

The Admin East Parking garage remains closed while painting operations are underway. A drop ceiling system has been installed and additional lighting down the middle of the garage has been added to better illuminate your parking experience.
