ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER

- Robert J. Frick, the Local Licensing Authority (the Authority) called the hearing to order at 3:00 p.m.

ITEM 3. APPLICATION FOR LIQUOR SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT APPLICATION

Licensee: Longmont Lodge #1548 Loyal Order of Moose, Incorporated
Premises: 2200 and 2210 Pratt St.
Manager: Glenn Reigle
Event Date and Time: August 15, 2020, from 10am until 11:59pm
Action Required: Approve or deny.

Glenn Reigle, manager appeared in person before the Authority regarding the proposed liquor special event application. As directed by the Authority at the last hearing on July 23, 2020, Reigle submitted a COVID safety plan to supplement the liquor special event application. No one from Boulder County Public Health Department attended the hearing, nor did Reigle have a written approval from Boulder County Public Health Department supporting the proposed special event.

Assistant City Attorney, Tim Hole, asked the applicant if something were to change for the worse before the event, if they would cancel their event. Reigle confirmed yes, the Moose Lodge would cancel the event.

The Authority advised Reigle that he would be willing to postpone and continue the hearing again until August 3, 2020 at 3pm to allow one last opportunity for Boulder County Public Health Department to participate in the review of the application and ensure the Authority the proposed event and safety plan are approved at the County level as it relates to the special event and COVID-19 protocols and restrictions. Reigle accepted the continuance of the hearing until August 3, 2020 at 3pm.
