Glenn Reigle, manager appeared in person before the Authority regarding the proposed liquor special event application. As directed by the Authority as the last hearing on July 29, 2020, Reigle submitted comments from Boulder County Public Health Department regarding the proposed special event and the service of alcohol during the event.


The Authority read the comments emailed to Reigle from John Holste with the Boulder County Public Health Department regarding their noted concerns about the event as proposed by the event organizer, the Moose Lodge.

Assistant City Attorney, Tim Hole, appearing before the Authority via teleconference, did not have any questions or concerns for the Authority. Hole advised the Authority that the comments and noted concerns provided by the County were persuasive and should be strongly considered.

The Authority ordered the liquor special event permit application denied based on the comments and concerns noted by the Boulder County Public County Health Department. The Authority authorized the refund of the liquor special event permit application fee back to the applicant.
