

Recycling Tip -- Coffee Cups

Coffee cups and lids from most commercial coffee houses are not recyclable or compostable. The fact of the matter is most coffee house cups are cardboard, but lined on the inside with a layer of plastic fused to the inside of the cup. That plastic layer excludes the cup from being compostable or recyclable.

If you use that style of cup, please toss it in the trash. One way to avoid creating trash is to use a reusable coffee cup or support coffee houses that use a certified compostable cup.

You can tell if a cup is compostable because it will have a green band around the cup and have the words “compostable”.

If it doesn't – it's trash
