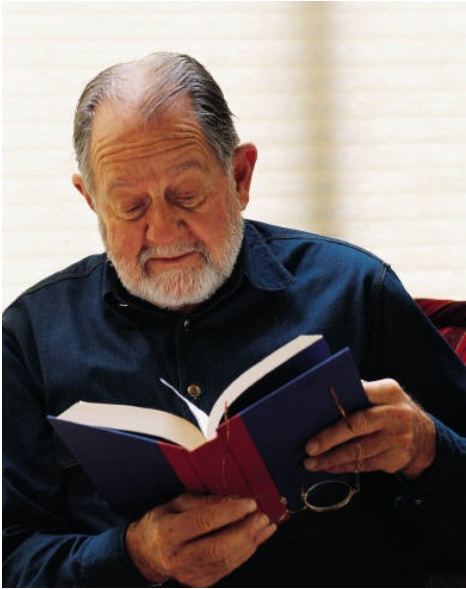

Homebound Delivery

Delivery of Library materials is available to Longmont residents who are confined to their homes.

Volunteers will select & deliver materials to you on a regular basis.

You're not responsible for fines on overdue items, but will be assessed a fee for any lost materials.

Information needed to enroll in the program includes name, address, daytime phone number and date of birth.

Book Collections

Collections of Library materials are available to retirement/care facilities and will be replaced with a new collection each month. Books-in-a-Bag kits are also available for book groups in retirement/care communities.

Available materials

include all regular type books (except reserve list items), an extensive large type collection of fiction and non-fiction which is easy on the eyes, audio books, DVDs and music on CD.
